Dear Parents:

Please find below a list of school supplies your child will need in September for Grade 4, 5, 6 LABEL EVERY ITEM CLEARLY WITH YOUR CHILD'S FIRST AND LAST NAME
Spare items will be stored in your child's locker until he or she needs them.

1. 2 Soft Pencil cases (no metal or hard plastic please), one for daily use items and one for markers & pencil crayons.
2. 50 GOOD pencils – cheap ones don't sharpen well and get used up VERY quickly. (Paper Mate is a good brand)
3. 2 red pens
4. Good quality pencil sharpener
5. 4 highlighters (different colours)
6. Fine tip felt markers (washable ones don't leak through the page)
7. Sharp point scissors
8. 5 glue sticks
9. Ruler, 30 cm
10. Half circle protractor (small, transparent) (*GRADE 5 and 6 ONLY*)
11. Simple four function calculator (*GRADE 5 and 6 ONLY*)
12. 8 Page Dividers (*Math 6 ONLY*)
13. 6 Pkgs. Of loose-leaf paper (at least 400 sheets)
14. 3 Flex 1 ½" Binders (5 Star Brand have good ones)
15. 10 Duo-Tangs
16. Homework Binder – Three ring binder with zipper, 2"
17. 2 Coil Scribbler (150 – 200 pages)
18. 2 packages of dividers for binder (10 or 12 dividers)
19. Recorder for music, German fingering, (best to be purchased through the school)
20. Gym clothes: shorts & shirt, sweatpants & sweatshirt for cold days
21. Indoor running shoes with non-marking sole
22. 3 boxes of Kleenex
23. One sturdy book bag – book bags with wheels do not fit in lockers
24. Water bottle
25. One pair gardening gloves (cheap dollar store ones are fine! Don't spend a lot!)
26. Visual Journal – Coiled Sketch Book 8.5 X11", 80 pages

1 Dictionary - Please note: It is important that **all** students have a good dictionary at home.

School dictionaries cannot go home and many assignments require dictionary. I recommend the Gage Canadian as we use it at school.

*Keep a small box of school supplies at home for homework. Some paper, pen & **pencil**, ruler, glue, scissors, and coloured pencils in a box can help make sure homework is done on time.

- * 1 coil scribbler with 150 pages or more. This will become the students' French Journal that they will use for notes and examples as we do not have a text book in French.
- * 1 Flex 1.5 Binder to be used for handouts
- * 1 Hilroy coil scrapbook for projects and vocabulary practice
- 2 packages of white-ruled index cards (3 x 5 size)

Please note! Students who were in my French class last year should not need to purchase these items if they are still in good condition.

Art 4-6

- 1 Flex 1.5 binder for handouts
- 1 Artist Sketchpad 9 x 12 size
- 1 box of wax crayons (at least 24 colors)
- 1 white eraser (Staedtler brand is good)
- 2 permanent ink black felt pens (Sanford Sharpie Brand)
- 1 fine tip and 1 ultra-fine tip – AVOID dual end pens
- 1 set of 24 pencil crayons sharpened – AVOID “Rose Art” brand
- 1 old Large, short sleeve t-shirt to be used as a messy art cover-up shirt

Please Note – Do not substitute duo-tangs for Flex binders. I need rings that open and snap shut.
